This week we want to encourage your group to do something a bit different. Since this is the week before Easter, “prayer stations” have been set up at Barclay A & B that are open daily from 7 to 9 p.m.

After this you may want to gather and debrief. Some questions you might use:

- What was it like worshiping God in this way?
- What did you notice as you entered into this experience?
- What did Christ seem to say to you as you prayed and were quiet?
- Are there ways we can be praying for each other as we head into the Easter weekend?
